JOINING A ZOOM VIDEO CONFERENCE

Background

In able to utilize Notre Dame's Cisco/Tandberg video conference infrastructure for video conferences, remote participants without an H.323 and/or SIP compatible endpoint can browse to Zoom.us from any computer that has a webcam, microphone and speakers connected to it. That allows them to participate, as a remote participant, in a video conference.

Process Overview

Browse to zoom.us and join a meeting. Zoom add-on may need to be installed and the meeting number must be known and entered to join that specific meeting.

1 On a computer that you wish to use to join the video conference (has a webcam, microphone & speakers connected to it), open a browser.




Open a browser.

2 Navigate to Zoom.us.




Navigate to the "Downloads" icon on the desktop of you Macbased computer and launch the "zoomusInstaller.pkg" download.


Launch zoomusInstall.pkg download.




6 Click on the "Continue" button.

While the Zoom application's icon is on the Mac "Dock" toolbar, right-click on it, go to "Options" and select "Keep in Dock". This will make it easier to launch the Zoom join meeting application in the future (you won't have to go to the Applications folder to launch it).

Keep Zoom icon in dock.



If you repeat the process, you should see that the "Keep in Dock" option is now checked. Don't click on it or you will uncheck/deselect the "Keep in Dock" option.



Verify
